### THURSDAY NIGHT WELCOME DRINKS SPONSORED BY QUADRANT CHAMBERS

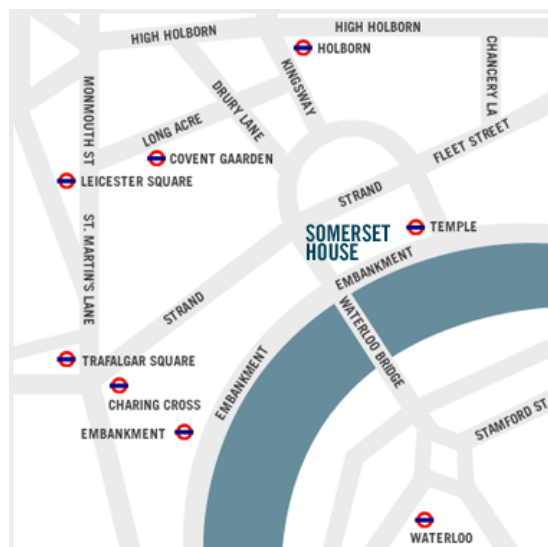

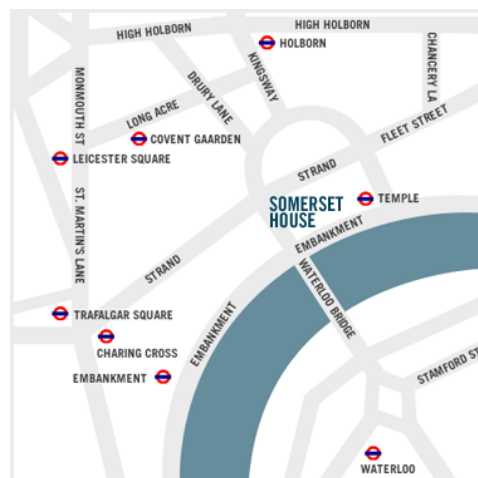
### FRIDAY NIGHT BOAT CRUISE
